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
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Editorial:

Glimpses of the God-Man MEHER BABA

Visit to Uttar Kashi

1948 — Part II By Bal Natu

Ordained Mission of The Avatar

As one reads the account of Meher Baba's contacts with the God-intoxicated souls—masts, at the outset as well as in retrospect, one comes upon a phase, unmatched in spiritual history. The work seemed so simple in its outward expression, yet in its effect, it was profoundly deep; so visible but abundantly penetrating. Especially in the forties, the work regarding the masts was 'the must' in Meher Baba's life; it far outweighed the other phases to which He paid attention. The inner life of the *mast* tendered a mystery and so the channels through which Meher Baba reached his dazed being, were inherently mystical. Undergoing great inconveniences and hardships, He reached the places where they dwelt. With ease of manner and gentle love, that was evident in Him, He carried on the divine work as an ordained Mission that none can take over until the Avatar gets enformed in His next Advent. This happens when humanity feels adrift and is in need of the Star to sail by, in the shoreless sea of Life.

The *masts*, with their mysterious states and peculiar traits, as explained by Meher Baba, are mostly found in India. So, very little is known about them in other countries; if any, it is in the form of distorted interpretations. Why should such Godintoxicated souls be found in India alone? It is a fair question. Instead of attempting to answer it myself, I feel it proper to quote two paragraphs from the book, perhaps the only book on the *masts*, The Wayfarers.*

India, Nearest To The "Creation Point"

Dr. Donkin writes, "A person of enquiring mind may wonder whether *masts* may be found in other parts of the world, and if they are not, then why it is that India alone is gifted with such souls. Meher Baba, in explaining this paradox to his disciples, told them once that India was nearest to the "Creation Point", and was, therefore, the most significant country in the world in the realm of spirituality. It was for this reason, He explained, that there were few *masts* outside India, and none in Europe or the Americas, although there were mystics, saints and God-lovers there. He told them, however, that there were a few *masts* in Arabia, a few in Egypt, a very few in Iran (mostly in Meshed and Tabriz), and a very few in Tibet.

"It is, therefore, not surprising that in the western world there are, as far as I am aware, no traditions about these Godintoxicated souls, and that when a westerner is confronted for the first time by the eccentric characteristics of a *mast*, his reaction is, quite possibly, one of incredulity and even abhorrence."

Meher Baba did not feel it necessary to explain much about the subtleties, involved in His work, with the *masts*. Again, there was no rigid method in contacting them except that He expected them to be in good mood at the time .of meeting them. Some high *masts* were contacted only once while a few had recurrent Baba-contacts. Sometimes there was a "regional concentration" as was in the case of Hyderabad and Baroda or the states of U. P. and the Punjab. In 1948, it was so in the case of Bombay. He paid a visit to this city in February, 1948 and wished to revisit it in March for contacting the comrades of God—the *masts*.

Masts of The Multifarious City

Immediately after the tripartite phase of forty days, Shri Baba commenced His work with the *masts*, in full swing. He visited Poona on the first day of March, to contact Shastri Kher. This advanced pilgrim chose his residence, in the open space near the vegetable market in the heart of the city. Once, he was a *shastri*, meaning well-versed in the scriptures and his

knowledge attracted crowds of people to him. Later, he discarded the load of learning and the God-Man felt impelled to visit him. From 15th March, 1948 commenced the second series of *mast*-contact in Bombay. The first one to come across was Nur Ahmed Baba, a Pathan in his sixties. He too, like Shastri Kher, was once a religious teacher. All of a sudden he realised the worthlessness of the intellectual approach to God. It was this propitious moment that hit him with the arrow of God love. The impact was so tumultuous that Nur Ahmed began to roam naked in the streets. What a blessedness to get lost in the wonder of that blissful Presence!

Meher Baba referred to such a type of masts as *Ittefaqi*. He explained, "An *Ittefaqi* is a *mast* who, without any love or longing, becomes suddenly, and accidently, intoxicated by Divine Love. The dominant mood or behaviour of an *ittefaqi* at the very moment of becoming intoxicated, colours all his subsequent behaviour as a *mast*." At the time of contact, Nur Ahmed was at Kurla, a suburb of Bombay and was held in great reverence by his kinsfolk, the Pathans.

In all, Shri Baba contacted eleven masts in Bombay. Shan Saheb was an advanced pilgrim. He always preferred to move about, wearing a long black kafani. The one located in Bhendi Bazar was a first grade pan (betel leaf) chewer, and the red spittle to a large extent had coloured his clothes. He had remarkable eyes. They reflected the blending of the sights of the far-off horizon and the heaven within. The naked Dhuni wala was unmindful of the seasons that passed. All day long he sat by the fire of the dhuni. Ahmed was a good mast. He was always seen with a sack, gunny cloth around his belly, He had, in his *masti*, given up the rest of the worldly riches. Nur Ali, with rings on all the fingers, was in the habit of constantly murmuring something to himself or to others. At the time of contact Shri Baba seemed to enjoy every bit of his non-sensical talk. It is said that the irrelevant words of *masts*, though rarely, displayed mystical fore-knowledge! Nuruddin swathed in dirt rags, roamed about everywhere in the city and slept anywhere he liked. Another *mast* named Ali Hussein would sit silent at different places, gazing mostly at the blue sky. Thus years

passed by. After contacting these diverse types of *masts*, in the multifarious city of Bombay, Shri Baba returned to Ahmednagar. But within a week. He left the headquarters for an extended tour to visit the eastern and northern parts of India, in search of God-intoxicated, God-communed, and Godabsorbed souls.

Calcutta, The Eastern Gate of India

The main target of this tour was to visit Uttar Kashi, in the Himalayan region. Gustadji, Kaka, Baidul, Chhagan and Eruch accompanied Shri Baba. On way to Caleutta, the party halted at Ambikapur (M. P.) where Shri Baba was received with great ovation by Jal Kerawalla. He was holding a high Government post of a Commissioner, at Ambikapur. I had no occasion to have any intimate talk with Jal Kerawalla. But he was the one with whom I wished I had some acquaintance. With his noble face he looked so graceful in person that one could not but grow fond of him. He was one of Meher Baba's endearing disciples. He was also one of the few persons whose residence was visited by Meher Baba even during the *mast* tours. This tour was not an exception and Shri Baba stayed at Ambikapur for a day and even agreed to hold a small *darshan* programme.

On 30th March, '48 Shri Baba was at Calcutta, the eastern gate of India. There He boarded a train for Dacca, the then capital of East Pakistan and now of the Bangla Desh. But as the train reached Rana Ghat, the frontier station, He decided to change the train that brought them back to Howrah (Calcutta). The *mandali* dared not question Shri Baba over this. They knew that they had to play their parts blindfolded with the conviction that the God-Man knew best. This indecisive and restless mood of Shri Baba continued all the more, during His stay in Calcutta, till the first *mast* was contacted.

An Out-of-the-way Condition

By the time, the train brought the Baba-party to Calcutta, it was 7-30 in the evening. Shri Baba consented to stay in a hotel for the night. Eruch knew the place where Shri Baba lodged during the last visit. This time Shri Baba, however, put forward an out-of-the-way condition. He proposed that His room should be at the end of the corridor way and that

there should be a vacant room in between His room and the *mandali's*, The Manager of the hotel was not expected to charge the party for the vacant room. Eruch, one of the *mandali*, was entrusted with this work. To his surprise, in one of the hotels, he found three vacant rooms on the fifth floor. He told the Manager that his elder brother (Baba) was very sick and was in need of a quiet atmosphere. So, the Manager agreed to give accommodation as was requested. Eruch had to spend more than an hour over this 'hotel hunt'. The party arrived at the hotel from the station. The *mandali*, though exhausted felt happy for Shri Baba got the rooms as desired.

By mid-night Shri Baba complained that the banging away at the anvils, in a nearby workshop, caused Him a great disturbance. Eruch, who was the night watch, got down the five flights of stairs and implored the proprietor of the work shop to discontinue the work of clanging, for the sake of his elder brother who was very ill. The proprietor consented to stop that noisy work. After an hour or so, Shri Baba who had a very sharp ear, detected some soft movements in the adjoining room. He told Eruch to enquire of the Manager for his breach of promise. Eruch was told that a respectable couple, unexpectedly arrived at the hotel and as the room was vacant, and the Baba-party was not anyway paying for it, the room was given to them. Eruch on way back, knocked at the door of the new companions, He explained to them about the delicate health of his elder brother (Baba). They agreed to be as noiseless as possible.

Master, The Wisest Of The Wise

Few minutes passed and there was a 'tick tick' on the door of Shri Baba's room. Shri Baba looked irritated and Eruch opened the door. He found the waiter with the ice water! Perhaps, the waiter missed the room and it was meant for the newly arrived couple. Whatever it be, by this time Shri Baba firmly announced to change the hotel. He gestured, "I cannot bear this commotion. We must move on to some quiet hotel." After a certain limit, none from the *mandali*, would argue with Shri Baba. Being convinced of the spiritual burden that Shri Baba bore for humanity, the *mandali* kept quiet and humbled, whatever He did or ordered in His agitated mood. Eruch woke

up the *mandali* resting in the other room and conveyed the decision of changing the hotel. Without raising any objection, all started packing up the bundles of luggage. Gustadji who was observing silence for over two decades began to convey something to Eruch through his gestures. Eruch in exasperation, said, "God bless me! I have to attend to two 'dumb persons'!" Just by this time Shri Baba stepped into the *mandali's* room. Looking at Eruch, He gesticulated, "Am I dumb?" Eruch felt sorry. He apologized and Shri Baba smiled away the remark.

Half asleep and half awake the party got down. At the time of settling the bill, there was some haggling at the counter. The man at the desk wondered at the behaviour of this party, whose members seemed to have come from the noble and respectable families. While loading the luggage in the *tongas* (horse-cabs), the person at the nearby workshop recognized Eruch and said, "You asked me to close the noisy work of moulding the iron. I agreed to it for the sake of your sick brother. Now, you are leaving the hotel at such an odd hour! How wonderful." What else could the mandali do than to apologize again and again to appease the person? Perhaps, Shri Baba who was sitting in the back seat enjoyed this joke. Because of the strange condition regarding the vacant room, it was difficult to get the required accommodation and on moved the cabs, from hotel to hotel. At last by 6-30 in the morning the party lodged in one of the hotels. Last night, the mandali had no supper, so Shri Baba allowed them to have a fine feast. All felt refreshed. But within two hours, Shri Baba, on one pretext or the other, wished to change the hotel. Why? He had His own reasons, that's all.

This incident is given in details to show that while engaged in His spiritual work, sometimes Meher Baba would be, to all appearances, extremely restless. The *mandali* who would be keeping company with Him had to bear the brunt of His mood, in the form of inconveniences, but in a cheerful spirit. Only after contacting the first *mast* in Calcutta, did Shri Baba's mood begin to show signs of His usual calm and gay nature. Here, I am reminded of the two couplets that Dr. A. G. Munsiff once

explained to me. The lines were in Urdu, The free interpretation of the couplets is as follows: However humiliating it may appear, in the company of the Master, the real life lies in annihilating your ego—the centre of intellectual reactions. Whatever the Master does, do not question His wisdom, He is not mad but the wisest of the Wise. He is that moth (*paravana*), God in human form, through whom, strangely enough the flame (*shamma*), the Light of lights is revealed. Oh, worldly wise, you have no idea of the Life of Love which includes infinite contradictions!

Contacting Masts In Calcutta

On 31st March in the morning, the first *mast* contacted was Mastan Shah. He was a rough, tough person with a sun-burnt skin, so common with the *masts*. He would loiter about the locality known as Central Avenue, muttering. The words as they come out from *masts* do not make sense to us. But in the case of some *masts*, they sound like the notes from a deep bell, with pleasing intonations. Shri Baba appeared pleased with this *mast*-contact and there was a marked change in His mood. Ramdas, Samsher Data and Rahim were old and moderate *masts*. It was said about Sufi Saheb, that for a period, over a decade or so, he did not sit or squat but either walked or remained standing. At the time of Shri Baba's contact, however there was a marked change in his outward behaviour. He had preferred to stay in a tiny room where he sat all day.

On 1st April, Shri Baba woke up very early and resumed a *mast* contact at 4 a.m. The next *mast* was Abdur Raheman, a moderate one. He was very fond of cats and dogs. Shaha Jehan was a high *mast* of the fifth plane. He had beside him, heaps of dusty, musty books as good as junk. The room had no windows and the possible ventilation through the door was blocked by a thick curtain. It can well be stated that the life of a *mast* is not the life of stoical suffering or self-denial but of God-reliance. Divine Providence alone protects them. At the end, Shri Baba visited one God-intoxicated soul who was abnormally fond of sweet oil. His body was smeared with oil and his clothes were drenched with it. He drank oil, in ample quantity with the fervour of the sweet drinks. In short, the *mast* looked very filthy. Shri Baba sat alone with him and the

quiet appeal made in silence, had a good response. The *mast* beamed with joy. Shri Baba also looked happy and remarked that it was the best contact in Calcutta. With this meeting Shri Baba's work in that great city and His restless mood too, were over.

Seek God With Intense Longing

By evening, the Baba-party boarded the Doon Express at Calcutta (West Bengal) for Hardwar (U. P.). They reached there on 3rd April, 1948. From there, Shri Baba was to proceed for Uttar Kashi. In the hallowed Himalayas, this sacred place lies, 4,000 feet above the sea level. It stands on the banks of the river Bhagirathi which is later known as the Ganga (Ganges), This centre of pilgrimage, from the days of old, is regarded as the reputed seat of Sanskrit learning. Its religious atmosphere is sanctified by the advanced souls who dwelt there for years. Now-a-days the buses take us right to this place. In 1948, from Tehri Garhwal, the pilgrims had to go on foot or ride on mules to reach Uttar Kashi. Again, the road was very unsafe and unprotected.

At Hardwar, Kaka and Chhagan were entrusted with the work of buying provisions for the journey to Uttar Kashi and back. With Baidul, Gustadji and Eruch Shri Baba set out on the look out of the advanced *sadhus* and the *masts*. As they were moving through the crowded lanes, Shri Baba pointed at an old person in rags, sitting on a wooden platform. He asked Eruch to enquire of this person about the *masts* in Hardwar. Collecting the information, the Baba-party left ahead. Soon, it was noticed that the man in rags was following them. Finding him rather persistent, Shri Baba asked one of the *mandali* to ascertain the reason of his pursuit.

At first the man responded saying, "I am in search of the Master, the Sadguru." In the next breath, directly addressing to Shri Baba with all humbleness he spoke, "I feel you are My Master." He gazed at Shri Baba and waited for His answering look. Shri Baba appeared pleased at his frank remark and the man was overjoyed. He blessed the old man and asked him to love God with intense longing and that Shri Baba would help him. After contacting some *masts* and *sadhus* in the city,

Shri Baba of Himself reopened the topic of the old man and appreciated how silently and deeply he 'wept' for the sight of God. Just then the same person reappeared. Shri Baba called him close and gave him three oranges as His *prasad*. He again advised him, "Seek God within you, with ever increasing love. One day you shall see Him. My blessings." Meher Baba's name was not disclosed to this old man. But Shri Baba's august presence did what was needed.

A Teenager, A Thirst For God

While moving incognito throughout India, Meher Baba had blessed and guided many a sincere soul. Rarely was His identity disclosed. Here is a story of a teenager who had left his home to find a Sadguru of his own choice. It was in 1942, the year when Meher Baba travelled over 15,000 miles from Ravalpindi (now in Pakistan) to Tanjore (Tamilnadu), to contact about 200 masts. In June, 1942 He was at Rishikesh which is about ten to fifteen miles away from Hardwar. Shri Baba was then residing with His eastern and western disciples in the bungalow of Rani Singhai, in the area known as Swarga Ashram. It was a sort of a forest ground. In those days, in this particular part there were some huts in which the sadhus lived and practised some sadhana (discipline). One day while returning to the Bungalow, Eruch noticed a handsome boy lying in one of the dilapidated huts. He was about fourteen years of age. By the way, Eruch remembered Shri Baba's instructions to find out one ideal boy for His contact. Naturally, he requested Shri Baba to visit the hut.

Meher Baba agreed and accompanied Eruch to the hut. He instructed Eruch to enquire of the boy and his intention to be there. The boy who spoke in Hindi told Eruch that he was from Ambala, where his parents resided. Because of the insatiable longing to see God, he felt impelled to leave the house. He decided to live in Swarga Ashram. Eruch asked him if he had a Master. The boy answered, "No. There are many *gurus* who only talk; and the mere words mean nothing. I earnestly desire for a *Sadguru* who *knows* but does not speak." At this Eruch gave him some information about Meher Baba and His silence. The boy said with dignity, "Yes, I have

recently heard about Meher Baba. I also learnt that He is residing some where in the neighbourhood." However, he added, "But Meher Baba is too great to accept me." Just then Shri Baba came forward and it was the most delightful moment in the life of that young boy. There opened up within him a great awareness and the beats of his own heart convinced him of Meher Baba's Godhood. He knew that God was compassionate but now he was surer than ever. When one is sincerely receptive to the will of God, one finds the shower of Grace, pouring upon oneself.

The Four Orders

Meher Baba conveyed through gestures that he was ready to be his Master. But the boy shall never see Him again in His physical form. If he was willing to abide by this condition Shri Baba wished him to obey four more orders for his lifetime. Then shall come a timeless moment, Shri Baba assured, when the boy will find God in his own heart as the Eternal Companion. Without any hesitation whatsoever, the boy happily consented and Shri Baba stipulated the following four orders:

- 1) In your entire lifetime, never touch a woman with the intention of lust.
- 2) Constantly and earnestly crave to realize the Divine Beloved—God.
- 3) Don't touch money; beg for your food.
- 4) Repeat all the time, Om Hari Narayan. (Shri Baba had asked the boy, his choice of repeating the name of God. The boy chose Om Hari Narayan. Shri Baba confirmed this as *Guru-mantra*.)

The meeting was over. Shri Baba smiled and thus assured the boy of His inner help, The teenager too smiled with Him. It was an expression that he would whole-heartedly abide by Shri Baba's orders, to his last breath. Shri Baba left the hut and the boy with all love in his eyes, continued to watch Him as far as his eyes could see, for he was not to see that Beloved Form again. The next day Shri Baba sent the boy a photo medal (with Shri Baba's form engraved on it) and a small booklet

(giving information about Meher Baba's life). A mat was also delivered to him along with some flour to be eaten as Shri Baba's *prasad*. The boy felt overwhelmed to receive these gifts. He continued to live in the woods of Rishikesh, famous for black scorpions and poisonous snakes. But now he was all the more fearless for he had taken refuge in the omnipresent and omniscient God-Man, Meher Baba. Wonderful were the ways of Shri Baba to meet and guide His dear lovers; and after the dropping of his body, they continue to be more incredible and graceful!

Seekers And Pilgrims Of Uttar Kashi

With a very short stay in Hardwar, Meher Baba reached Rishikesh on 4th April, 1948. Nine coolies were engaged to carry the luggage of the party to Uttar Kashi via Tehri Garhwal. It was the last outpost for the bus traffic. Tehri was a town buried in a "hot steamy valley" and the track from Tehri to Uttar Kashi was narrow and rough. It had to be crossed at one's peril. The walk often raised blisters on the toes and in summer, the sun beat on the back. In short, it was a hazardous and wearisome march, but contacting the love-thirsty seekers and pilgrims of Uttar Kashi was the need of the time. On 7th April, '48, the party set out on the journey on foot from Tehri Garhwal. The first stop was in the forest-bungalow at Syansu and the second was in the Kali Kamhaliwala Chetty (Dharmashala) at Dharasu. Shri Baba reached Uttar Kashi on 9th April and all made themselves comfortable in the Birla House, a massive dharmashala. The 'divine outings' for contacting the pilgrims and sadhus commenced the next day.

Falahari Baba was an initiate pilgrim. He subsisted only on fruit, flowers and roots. He wore just a loin cloth, irrespective of the cold weather in winter. Ramdasji, another advanced soul, went a step ahead. All the year round he used to remain naked, He was also observing silence. He lived in a hut, a few miles away but visited Uttar Kashi to collect his daily bread. Gayanand lived in Kailas Ashram. His room was pretty dark but this advanced soul, who was fairly old, spent most of the time reading one book or the other. Shri Baba liked Gayanandji and so paid him a second visit. The old man looked overjoyed and his happiness was redoubled. For

contacting some other seekers, Shri Baba had to tread narrow foot-paths, and move through hills and dales. Among the ten seekers and *sadhus*, contacted at various places, there was a centenarian named Mangalagiri Maharaj. "His back was so bent and his body so thin that when he squatted his head almost touched the feet." This visit of Shri Baba made him feel that his age was amply rewarded and that he was blessed.

Love Gestures Of "Flying Kisses"

A contact with a *mast* from Bengal, who had decided to stay in this far-off place, must needs be mentioned. This Godintoxicated soul, Nirgunanandji, was in his eighties. His face, rather the whole frame, was wrinkled as a walnut. His shabby clothes which seemed unwashed for days, showed signs of long use. In spite of his age, his blithe spirit and energy were admirable. He lived in a small, low room in the Durga Devi temple. Welcoming Shri Baba, the *mast* personally led Him to the room. It was late evening and darkness prevailed in his room. So, Nirgunanandji lit a match and began to have a look at Shri Baba's body—the Light enformed. Beholding the divine lustre of Shri Baba's face, he seemed immensely delighted. Shri Baba too, joined him in his gay mood. Perhaps, for Shri Baba, this was the last and the most pleasing contact of the day.

The next day, by daybreak Shri Baba continued to move about visiting huts and cottages for contacting ardent aspirants and God-mad *masts*. In a nearby village named Tilot, lived Vishnu Datta Digambar. He was an outstanding personality. Shri Baba remarked that he was a *mast*, saint and child rolled in one. May be, as a *mast*, he wore no clothes, as a saint he was observing silence and as a child he would beg for food at any house, but only in the five. He ate with pleasure whatever he received. Shri Baba gestured that he was a *mast* of a very high type. Both seemed extremely happy to meet each other and it was a comfort to be in each other's arms. After the meeting, as Shri Baba departed, the *mast* made very loving gestures of "flying kisses" at Shri Baba. To witness such love signals was a sight unforgettable!

Rich Spiritual Inheritance Of Uttar Kashi

On 12th April, '48, Shri Baba visited a seeker named Ramanandji. He had long ash-daubed hair. Being naked he

was also known as Nanga Baba. The last but not the least meeting was with Devigiri Maharaj. In a way it was the first and the foremost contact of an advanced soul from Uttar Kashi. Because, while journeying by train from Calcutta to Hardwar, Shri Baba pointed out at Benares, at a venerable old person in ochre coloured robes, flanked by two young sanyasis. With reference to him Shri Baba remarked, "A very good soul." He then asked Eruch to get the whereabouts of that person. It turned out that he was from Uttar Kashi where he had an Ashram. His name was Devigiri Maharaj and he was on his return journey. Owing to the request of some of his devotees he however, got down from the Doon Express at Ayodhya. But perhaps, as wished by Shri Baba, he returned to his headquarters in time, to receive the blessed and redeeming touch of the Real One, to whom he was whole-heartedly devoted, may be with a different name and in a different form! With the presence of these rare souls like Nirgunanandji, Vishnu Datta, Devigiri Maharaj and a few others, Uttar Kashi maintained the rich spiritual atmosphere.

On 13th April, Shri Baba left Uttar Kashi. By 18th, He reached Agra via Delhi, He halted there for three days. The main motive of course, was to meet *masts* and to feed them with His love. A few seekers too had Shri Baba's heavenly and healing touch. One of the prominent *masts*, was Majzoob Baba. He held himself as the Emperor of Agra. The choice of his residence was by the mental hospital. Shri Baba, however, told the *mandali* that in spite of his nonsensical talk and the seat near the mental asylum, he was a good *mast*. Haji Baba lived in a mosque and was fond of giving away money, whatever he had at hand, to the people. He referred to his room in the mosque as a tavern and to himself as a drunkard. In fact, he meant that the wine he had, was that of love for God. By 22nd April, 1948, Shri Baba returned to Ahmednagar.

While returning from Uttar Kashi, Shri Baba brought with Him a lively, dainty creature. For the succeeding years, it reminded the *mandali* of those thrilling and perilous 'outings' near about Uttar Kashi, in search of earnest seekers and spiritually advanced souls. What was it?

My Tour in Hamirpur District and BABA'S LOVE FEAST

At the invitation of Shri Parameswari Dayal Nigam (Pukar) of Hamirpur, requesting me to participate in the PREMA -MELA (Lovers Gathering) at Meherpuri, Hamirpur and in the VIRAT - MELA (Universal Gathering) at Meher Dham, Nauranga on 17th, 18th, 19th of November 71 and 25th November 71 respectively, I started on the 14th November 71 night from Hyderabad by Delhi Express. In this pilgrimage, I carried with me the good wishes of lovers of Hyderabad and Secunderabad for the success of the functions. The train reached Jhansi on 15th night at about 9-30 p.m., and to my great joy there joined with me many lovers of Jhansi. We have taken the next passenger train towards Lucknow and got down at Kalpi Railway station by 3 a.m., on 16th. Early in the morning we took the first bus from Kalpi to Hamirpur and reached Meherpuri (Hamirpur) where Pukarji brothers and Sitaram Barfiwala gave us a hearty reception and provided us with good accommodation in a huge mansion at Meherpuri. Lovers poured in, one after another from different places to share the joy and blessings of great function. On 17th morning Brothers Gulabdas Panchal & party from Bombay along with Mrs. Khorshad K. Irani and Brother W. D. Kain of Delhi and Bro. Nafde of Bhopal arrived. Prominent among the local lovers are M/s. Bhavani Prasad and his son Krishna Bhushan, Headmaster of the school, Shri Kesav Narayana Nigam, Sital Prasad, Om Prakash Tripathi, Swamideva Sarma, Ali Bux, and Udith Narayan Sarma, who is the minister of the Uttar Pradesh Government from Hamirpur.

The functions at Hamirpur were arranged to commemorate the First Darshan of Avatar Meher Baba at Hamirpur and to celebrate the first annual function of the unveiling of Baba's statue. The first day functions were well attended by local elite and the public. Baba Sankirtan and gathering of lovers were held on first and second days, very successfully. On the third day a special gathering of lovers and workers was held. I had the good opportunity of addressing the gathering and

Bro. W. D. We have visited the houses of Lakshmanchand Palival and family, Brinda Prasad Nigam and Bhagavati Prasad. It was really an unfathomable joy of homely reception and unsophisticated devotion of the lovers of this holy place once visited by beloved Baba and blessed by his personal contacts. The memories of experiences of the lovers of this village and the privileges enjoyed by them on the occasion of beloved Baba's stay with them are really encouraging and their simplicity in Baba's love and the hospitality accorded by them have made us all feel as one family so endearing to each other.

From here, we have proceeded to Maheva where we met M/s. Mahendra Pal Nigam and Mukund Lal Nigam and enjoyed their hospitality at that holy place. We visited Meher-Astana the holy place where beloved Baba has revealed his Avatarhood for the first time to the world in 1952 when he was there in great seclusion. The cottage and the holy place on the hillock which was surcharged with the Divine presence of the Avatar of the age, has given us the thrill of life and the experience of loving presence of Baba filling the heart of every one of us with joy and peace. This is the place Bro. Kesav Narayan Nigam. But he was away to Bombay and so we missed him on this occasion. On the way we visited Kabari where Bro. Balbir Singh, has received us. On 22nd night, we reached Rath, where Mrs. & Mr. Gayaprasad Khare and their son Adarsha Bhushan Khare have received us. Their love and devotion to Baba were admirable. We were quite at home with them for the night.

After Breakfast on 23rd morning, our party led by Pukarji reached Nauranga at a distance of 10 miles by 3 p.m. The tractor that has carried us through the uneven places and fields and through dusty storm has given us the experience of ruggedness of country life, but the hearty reception and the loving embraces of Nauranga Brothers has overwhelmed us with joy and so much we enjoyed their shower bath of love. Soon after we had a cool bath, and were served with Tea and refreshments. Elaborate arrangements were made for all the lovers invited for the Virat Mela which was to commence from 25th November '71. Lovers from all over India poured in by that day. Brother Chagan Master came with a troop of half-a-dozen young American lovers from Ahmednagar, carrying with him a special message from Meharazad Mandali for the occasion. Those among the American group of lovers were 1) Gill Alvarado of Sanfrancisco, 2) John Foreman of Weston, 3) Allan Cohen of Westbury, New York, 4) Patrick Larlson of California, 5) Erico Nadel of Yellow Springs, Ohio, 6) Mrs. Anne Paterson of Aspen, Colorado. Among those that have come from Delhi were, Bro. Dixit, Rupchand Sharma, and Dr. R. P. Yadav of Avatar Meher Baba Dispensary, Bhorakalan (Haryana) & Rajanikant from Jabalpur.

The functions commenced on 25th morning with Flag hoisting by Chagan Master. At 8-15 a.m. Exhibition was opened by Bro. Gulabdas. On the first and second days there were Bhajans and Sammelans. Talks were given by Bros. K. N. Nigam Rajanikant and Swami Satyaprakash Udaseen. Speeches were given by Swami Satyaprakash Udaseen & Swami Brahmananda besides Swamiprasad Sinha. A great Dinner was served to all lovers at 11 a.m.

Thanks must be given for the organizers for these most successful functions that have inspired many and the love-feast enjoyed all these days was in particular due to the great dedication and devotion of Bro. Babu Ram Prasad and those of his colleagues who have co-operated and shared with him the love of labour of whom mention must be made of: M/s. Hiralal, Madanlal, Siddha Gopal, Janak Singh & Nathuram Sastri. The uniqueness of the function was the camp life, provided by the organisers, its simplicity and universality without distinction of any kind, but with equal attention for necessities of rest and food. The four days of our stay there with the overflowing guests from far and near, with loving attention and exuberant hospitality, was indeed, a love-feast. His Divine presence has pleased every heart that has the fortune to join the functions.

Again on 28th morning our party led by Bro. Pukarji and Chagan Master with the added strength of westerners arrived back at Rath on a tractor again and from there to Bahadurpur on bus where we were received by Chaturbuj Saxena who arranged for our light refreshments. The entire caravan of Meher Pilgrims now got into carts dragged by two Bulls each and travelled on a country track to Byarjio. The procession was taken round the village for two hours and at last it reached the top of a hill where it converted itself into a public gathering. Bro. Chagan Master presided and declared the Meher Ashram there open. Shri Rajanikant and Swami Satya Prakash spoke on the occasion. The Ashram is ideally located in a scenic spot that abounds in natural beauty. There flows a rivulet round the hill. The cool shade of the green trees and the sylvan beauty of the spot make one very pleasant. Bro. Chagan Master is a natural leader, very much respected and loved like a father, by the people of Hamirpur. Bro. Saxena, Hariprasad and Geeta Ram and their colleagues are specially blessed for their choice in setting the Ashram there and their devotion for Baba is unsurpassed, Their hospitality and love that has been showered on the party was, indeed, deeper than can be expressed.

On the morning of 29th lovers and villagers of Byarjio have arranged a grand procession with two elephants and Bhajan parties. Here again Chagan Master and all the American Lovers were made to ride on elephants, holding aloft Baba's portrait and Flag. They have enjoyed the ride with the shouts of "Avatar Meher Baba Ki Jai" which were quickly responded to by the villagers with one voice in unison. The ladies and children have taken this opportunity to garland and give Arati to Baba at every house. So much was the joy that was witnessed that they danced to the tunes of Bhajans in the streets, forgetting other matters. Swami Satyaprakash Udaseen who had selected to walk with the procession rather than to ride on the elephants was subject to a tidal wave of affection from the villagers who had profusely garlanded him and applied tilak on forehead that he looked like a well adorned bride!

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It was with a heavy heart, that we took leave of these affectionate people who have flooded us with their love. We left again by Bullock carts to Rath road and again by bus to Rath town.

At this stage there is a sad news to mention. On 25th night Mrs. Gayaprasad Khare passed away taking Baba's name until her last breath. So we visited their house on the evening by which time their eldest son Dr. Brij Bhushan, Residential Medical Officer of Benares University, who had the unique good fortune as Baba and mandali stayed with him as guests during their New Life, was also there. We offered our condolences and prayed for the peace of the departed soul.

The party now divided itself into two. Pukarji and Chagan Master with the Western-group went to Maheva and Meher Astana and myself with Bombay group with Shri Panchal reached Hamirpur back at 9 p.m. by a special taxi. On 30th night Pukarji and Chagan Master with their group reached Hamirpur from Meherastana and we had a pretty good time once again with entertainments of Meherpuri-school children in music and art and enjoyed the hospitality of Pukarji and family once again. On the first morning all of us including the Western group were invited to Kanpur by Bro. Sitaram Barfiwala and

we reached there by buses in the afternoon. The reception and hospitality accorded to us by Shri Sitaramji and his family and other co-workers was so sweet and hearty that it was a mixture of Baba-love and Barfi. Special programmes were arranged and Baba Sankirtans were sung. Press conferences were called. Western Brothers and sisters were made to speak about their experiences for two days. We have once again, as one Baba family forgot everything else of the world except eating sweets and taking Baba's love to the brim of our hearts. On this occasion the special attention paid to us all by M/s. Sitaramji, Premkumar Jain, Ramakishore Vajapaye, Raja-kumar Sharma and other members of A. M. B. Kanpur Centre was so great that we were overwhelmed with love and joy and when we have to part and go back to our respective places, we found ourselves unable to move out. The hearty send off accorded to us by the Kanpur group of lovers who saw us off at the Kanpur Railway Station was a rare expression of love. Brother Chagan Master and Western lovers proceeded to Ahmednagar and myself with Pukarji and party reached Jhansi from where I took leave of them with 'Jai Baba' and with parting embraces and love greetings. On the way to Jhansi, by beloved Baba's special blessings, we came in contact with Dr. Suresh Sastri of Jhansi, who is a learned scholar and a lover of God doing a great service to humanity.

By Baba's grace, I had the good opportunity of partaking the love feast and Divine manifestation of Beloved Baba, during the aforesaid functions of Hamirpur District which Baba declared as his heart. May beloved Baba bless us all to have such occasions so as to strengthen our faith and love for the Avatar of the age and hold on to His Daman until the last breath of our lives.

Salvation By "Baba" Nama Japam

Uttering the name of the Lord is of 4 ways: 1) repeating the name of the Lord audibly; 2) Repeating the name of the Lord by moving the lips without making any sound; 3) mental repetition of the name of the Lord without moving the lips; 4) repeating the name of the Lord always without making the sound, moving the lips and without making the mind know of it. In order to repeat the name of the Lord, we have to select a musical name in the form of a "mantra" which must be given by a Master to His disciple. It is stated that only when such mantra of a name is given through the mouth of a Sadguru will become fruitful in realising God or desired object. Baba has already given His name to all of us to repeat daily more than fourteen times. Baba's nama-japa may be taken as one of the methods of loving Baba. By nama-japa one knows how to love Baba really even though there are several ways of loving Baba. By loving Baba wholeheartedly one can transcend from Sensation to reason, from reason to intuition and to higher inspiration and ultimately to realisation. One has to cross seven spiritual planes of consciousness through gross, subtle and mental bodies. After realising God, some may give up the body immediately. Some may become Majzubs who are not conscious of creation and their bodies but who experience constantly the infinite bliss, Power and knowledge. They cannot use the power for others. Some may become Videha-muktas. But a few will become

Sadgurus. At every age the Sadgurus are five in number. They constantly experience the Infinite Peace, Power and Knowledge and also use all these Powers for the sake of the other men.

When such realisation of God and becoming Sadgurus are expected from the Avatar of the age, it is a minor thing to counteract the destructive nuclear weapons. Even a single Baba lover with a stroke of one single narna-japa wholeheartedly can counteract not only the nuclear weapon but any destructive weapon on the earth. The most important thing is that it is not only to normalise the situation by counteracting the destructive weapons but also to build up a new world order in which one loves the other with a clear-cut feeling of brotherhood realising the spiritual aspect of life. Baba Nama-japa is one of the means to achieve the end.

Baba's Message of Love

By a Baba Lover

The only God is KNOWLEDGE and the only evil is ignorance. Knowledge of what? Knowledge of God—The Infinite Bliss. One should know that not he that adorns but he that adores makes Divinity.

We, modern men and women, are not in need of sound advice and original ideas but we all want experience. We do not want some one who can help us to think more clearly or even one who can tell us what to do. We want something done; we want, exhibited as a reality, the life that we are deeply conscious. In short, we want not an intellectual demonstration of truth, but the truth itself. We knew what science teaches. We have already astronauts who have circled

the earth travelling through space. We have 50 ton Megaton bombs. We need not know any more. We want the evidence of knowledge (gnosis) put into practice, for we are living all our lives in uncertainty, challenge, fear and peril.

It is here that the need of a Guru is felt or some one with a consciousness greater than ours who can take us a step further. We do not need any more knowledge, except one and that is the knowledge of God or the Ultimate Reality. In that knowledge every thing is contained. We should select such a teacher who has achieved complete self-mastery and has reconciled and transcended the opposites that divide the life of man. He should be child-like yet wise; joyous but profound; humble yet authoritative. The Perfect Masters have that knowledge. The Perfect Master of whom I speak and write has that knowledge. He is AVATAR MEHER BABA. He is a Master of Perfect Masters. He has conscious knowledge of God. Baba says I am the Ancient One, the One Beloved residing in the hearts of all individuals. Undoubtedly I am the Ancient One, I reside in all. Therefore, if you can love all and make them happy and serve them at your own cost and at the cost of your comforts, then that would be loving Me—that is loving Me who is the Beloved residing in every individual heart."

Meher Baba has not come with any new message or to found any new religion. He says "I have come not to teach but to awaken." The gnosis of Meher Baba was never found to be in conflict with any religion or with the teachings of the Perfect Masters the world has already known.

The essence of Shri Avatar Meher Baba's message is LOVE—Love him unreservedly, resign yourself completely and unequivocally to him. By this he does not mean that one should hate others—rather it is exactly the opposite—Love one and all as BABA IS ALL PERVADING. By this one cultivates the habit of LOVE and destroys the habit of hatred, because hatred begets hatred. To love and put it into action one has to sacrifice his own happiness and comforts for the sake of one he loves and not do mere lip-wisdom.

Here the love is of two kinds i.e., sacrificing one's own happiness and comforts for the return of something and the other is spontaneous sacrifice without any expectation of material gains or any return. The latter is more important, as the former contains the POISON of 'SELF'.

The next quest that comes to one's mind is "What happens if I cultivate the habit of love or sacrifice my own happiness for the sake of others." The answer is you get the habit of sacrifice—'Thyaga'. One may ask again "Why Thyaga or Vyragya is necessary." It is necessary because Vyragya means free from WANTS and free from wants means the control of the wavering mind. All this practice and trouble is to stabilise the monkey-like mind from inconstancy.

When one thus controls the mind it leads the DEHI (person) to lose ABHIMANA and AHANKARA and forget his 'SELF' and this 'SELFLESS' state is the ripe and right path for the realisation and enjoyment of that INFINITE BLISS. In short the God to be worshipped and the means required for it are within one's self. Shri Baba says "I am one of you, one with you and one in you and we are all One. To realize this oneness, love God wholeheartedly and honestly, sacrificing everything at the altar of this supreme Love and you will realize the Beloved within you."

One must know that before aspiring for that Infinite Bliss one must be worthy of it. We generally say that Mr. so and so is clean like washed rice; in this it is implied that rice becomes acceptable, edible, only after washing it, meaning thereby, that by itself rice is not usable. To bring the rice into edible form, it has to be pounded first, i.e., it has to bear good beating first; having thus brought it in usable form then it has to be washed clean and then cooked; then alone it can be offered as Naivedya. In the same way, a man has to undergo suffering before he becomes qualified for the Grace of God. Shri Baba says "Those who lose their all in Me find their all in Me ever after."

Later on once Baba emphasised the importance of Meherpuri to Pukar expressing that Meherpuri had already been constructed under His Divine-plan.

Prior to dropping his physical body, Baba held the last meeting in the second week of Oct. 1968 and Pukar was specifically called to attend this meeting, he had his stay for three or four days in Meherazad on that occasion. Beloved Baba, first thing which he directed to Pukar was to complete the plan of Meherpuri soon, seeking the help of His lovers. Since then Pukar has put his life at stake to complete the work and made several tours and sincere appeals to seek help from each and every lover from all over the east and west.

Since then more than 3 years have passed, although several lovers have given valuable help and much has been done, still it is a huge task and much more remains to be done.

The lovers can no longer afford to prolong the completion of the scheme of Meherpuri, and they should be anxious to carry out the will of the Beloved soon.

It is therefore an earnest appeal to all the Baba lovers to cooperate in fulfilling this sacred mission and expedite the remittance of their love gifts from the minimum to maximum amount they can afford, in one or more, in monthly or annual installments. Avatar Meher Baba's 78th Birthday Celebrations

ANAKAPALLE:

The 78th Birthday celebrations of Avatar Meher Baba were commenced on 10-12-71 at Avatar Meher Baba Centre, Anakapalle. Puja & Sankeerthan was performed on this day from 6-30 A.M. to 8-30 P.M. Br. P. S. R. Swamy narrated some of the Birthday messages of Avatar Meher Baba on this occasion, especially "Birth and Death are natural Phenom-enon and real death is one, when the soul eternally gains birth in the eternal soul." As such, he said that whatever may be the normal permanences of Birthday Celebrations, the real approach is the ever remembrance of the Beloved, with ardent love for Him and internal devotion to gain the real eternal birth in the Divinity. He also prayed that such an ardent and pure love may be showered on all the lovers to lead them to gain the end.

Weekly Sammelans were subsequently performed on every Saturday & Sundays in the Balavihar and Meher Centres respec-

tively and many lovers participated on these occasions. Special sammelans were also performed in the residences of lovers during this period and Sivarathri Night Vigil and Nam Sankirthan, and Bhishma Ekadasi Sammelan were performed in Meher Baba Vihar Centre. A Special feature during this sacred period is the performance of marriage of a silent lover's daughter conducted on 4-2-72. The lover has completely subdued himself to Beloved Baba and his internal love is depicted in keeping Baba's attractive cut-out garlanded and placed in a well decorated Sofa, opposite to the marriage mandapam, and the commencement of the marriage proceedings actually started after his prayers and offering Arathi to Baba. It appeared thrilling and elevated not only to the lovers but to all the visitors.
