JALGAON, May 12.

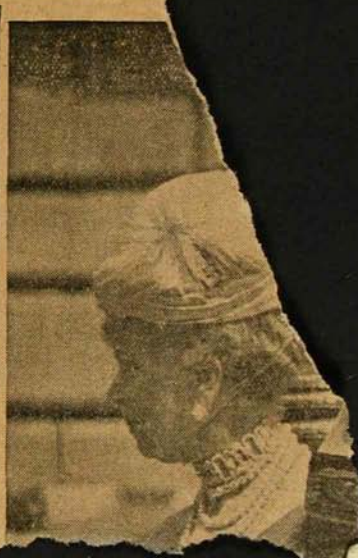
