Immediately after His return from the West on November 15th - declared, before the Mandali, that He wished to touch the feet of thousands - even 3200 - this time on His birthday - for reasons of His own, "This year" He declared, "has a great importance and significance, and I want not only thousands of the poor & the destitute & others to whom I intend giving some special "prasad" from Me & touch their feet, but I want all - my devotees & others - as many as could be gathered & could come, to be near Me on the occasion, for the special benefit all will have of the time, and on the spot. He wanted about 20 thousand - for Himself to touch their feet and to receive His "prasad" - and wanted to know if these could be arranged to come to Nasik on the day, wanted some one to undertake to collect these. Rustam Undertook it - Others to help. Raunaq, Vimala, Shri (Dr.) & Ch. were told to write to all devotees, friends & others, inviting them the present on the occasion -

The days fixed by H. were 17 & 18th February - altho His actual birthday, according to Persian calendar falls on the 15th - Why He selected these days, He alone knows. None realised at that time what days these were, in consideration of the coming elections for the legislative assemblies throughout India - fixed on the 17th of February, when the bulk of India would be busy, one way or the other, to take advantage of the opportunity of this election for the legislature. According to the New constitution to be formed for the Self Government of India - - - A very important, and epoch-making history of India to coincide with the celebration of His birthday. May be significant of the spiritual link with the material, but what a coincidence? All would be busy, torn between Matter & spirit!
