 overcrowded - double exposure, double load - found our way in in the extreme
 rear carriage, outside the platform - - - packed rather uncomfortable.
 Night - we had to be alert to be awake before we arrive Raichur -

 at 5-15 A.M.

J... stays till the train leaves at 2:40 - An Ambekar Schuster for me, having to stick up to talk etc for @ 2 hours without work & tea - ... but for the love they have for B... we have to put up with these circumstances to be thinking I will have ample time to rest & have tea at in train en route. I didn't mind. But meanwhile there was such a terrible rush of passengers (some tickets) that it was overcrowded. Only 5 bogies, none extra being attached. I could have spoken to the S.M. - but couldn't leave the lady who was specially awaiting to hear news of B... & besides there were my prejudices there mind that we were of a 'nature'. However, I did draw the S.M.'s attention at the first stop - Arakonda - pointing out the crowds packed like sardines in the 5 bogies - we were 30 in a compartment for B... But the official tried to explain away the situation in his cold business like attitude - to create a storm was a real opportunity, but I had other more important duties to attend to and kept quiet. My bedding, suit case, hand bag all were stowed in the compartment - the passage was blocked & it was with difficulty I could find my way to my seat which again was occupied by others - 9 others on a seat for 5 with 2 kiddies on the lap.
