Muscar & Muddurubed ^{at dark} in the residential quarters - All Calculation & Clairvoyance of the poor (B.G.P.D.) which predicted his arrival before 7.30 pm. were thwarted, and even his party had come ahead to meet B. crossed the bus en route - so that they all came at about 9 p.m. - After B. & party had arrived & settled ^{as he wanted - &} inside, ~~awaiting~~ the Unloading & removal of baggage (bedding only) by female ^{bracket} who were ^{sent by} Major after they arrived with Meak. which was taken at @ 9.30 - bedding took about an hour to be sorted out & shifted to ladies' quarters - they went to bed @ midnight.

B. had given all to understand at first that they were going to Chadrager Residential Quarters of Mad. Sri Krishna Prasad & they had all expected to be ushered in, on arrival, to some splendid bungalow - ready for a hearty dinner & nice soft beds to rest during the night. What rude shocks they all received when they found themselves in the "Gola" (Puro ladies) quarters - open veranda with no furniture or anything except their own bedding, etc. done! But these are the lessons all have to learn - thru surprise shocks like these - to get over Maya!

The big Scheme - for the Centre, discussed with Major-Mohammed & Akbar Kuran - took an interesting turn. - They were all border-struck to see the fine plan (the rough, drawn by Walter) and the ideas of different Ashraus it contained, and were v. enthusiastic about it. It was Amazy to watch B's secret subtle working, to mend, twist & turn things, as he wants, over their heads who become the ^{unconscious} mouth pieces of B. to say things as he wants! K.H. who would be the least expected, took such keen interest in the entire discussion, and v. helpfully cut the M. short every time he was over-enthusiastic or optimistic & himself (K.H.) put in some v. practical suggestions & hints - as B. would like. In short it was he who became B's mouth piece - a ^{far} more pleasant taste of telling things. Not acceptable to the over-enthusiastic & self-dominating workers! But B. uses all - good & bad - even a crack, for his work where their services would be useful, even paupering them & overlooking their carelessness & mistakes ^{to} "keep in touch". But thus far, and no further! They automatically adjust themselves and take shape to the design of his work - as he wants, either thru his personal work & instruction or thru some other medium who become his mouth piece.
