Near my seat the man had a serious complaint to the extent of size which brought tears to his eyes. On the way - he pointed out to a man in the street - apparently a beggar in rags, unconscious of his surroundings, and ordered A... to give him a coin (2 an) - the explanation was offered for this at the moment. Now could we ask him, as he seemed mentally occupied & busy elsewhere.

After a while, having driven how many a thoroughfares, he abruptly called for a turn rather <sup>simultaneously</sup> <sup>quietly</sup> <sup>by</sup> <sup>expressed</sup> <sup>changed</sup> & <sup>with</sup> <sup>to</sup> <sup>him</sup> <sup>a</sup> <sup>typical</sup> <sup>turn</sup> home. Rumours went round that they were his brothers and wanted to take him away. Others took quite a different view & said that we were speculators and want to keep these "Masts" with us in order to get figures for them - as is the practice in many places by people who want to get wealthy overnight, with speculation or getting a No. in lotteries etc. His ~~defiance~~ was unshaken, but at the eleventh hour, a Longavalla who was well acquainted with him appears on the scene, & offers to persuade him, and after having a little talk, actually lifts him & puts him by a

Co. in charge of the two (in B's room) Gurb. & Chaji, awaiting tonga till 4-30. NO body turned up. Hence they stayed at house. At the dargah also, none (as previously arranged) appeared, hence B. just went round quietly, did the work all the same, and returned by about 5 AM. (details Adh-baka)

Then after tea, commenced the search for the God-men & even other beggars, twenty of whom were brought to B. as required — B. shaved, washed and cleaned them all till 1 p.m. and took his meals after finishing all this, when he was too tired after hours of continued & strenuous service with the 20 to be <sup>shaved</sup> washed, cleaned.

No feast — Dal rice (lunch) — dal & bread (evening)

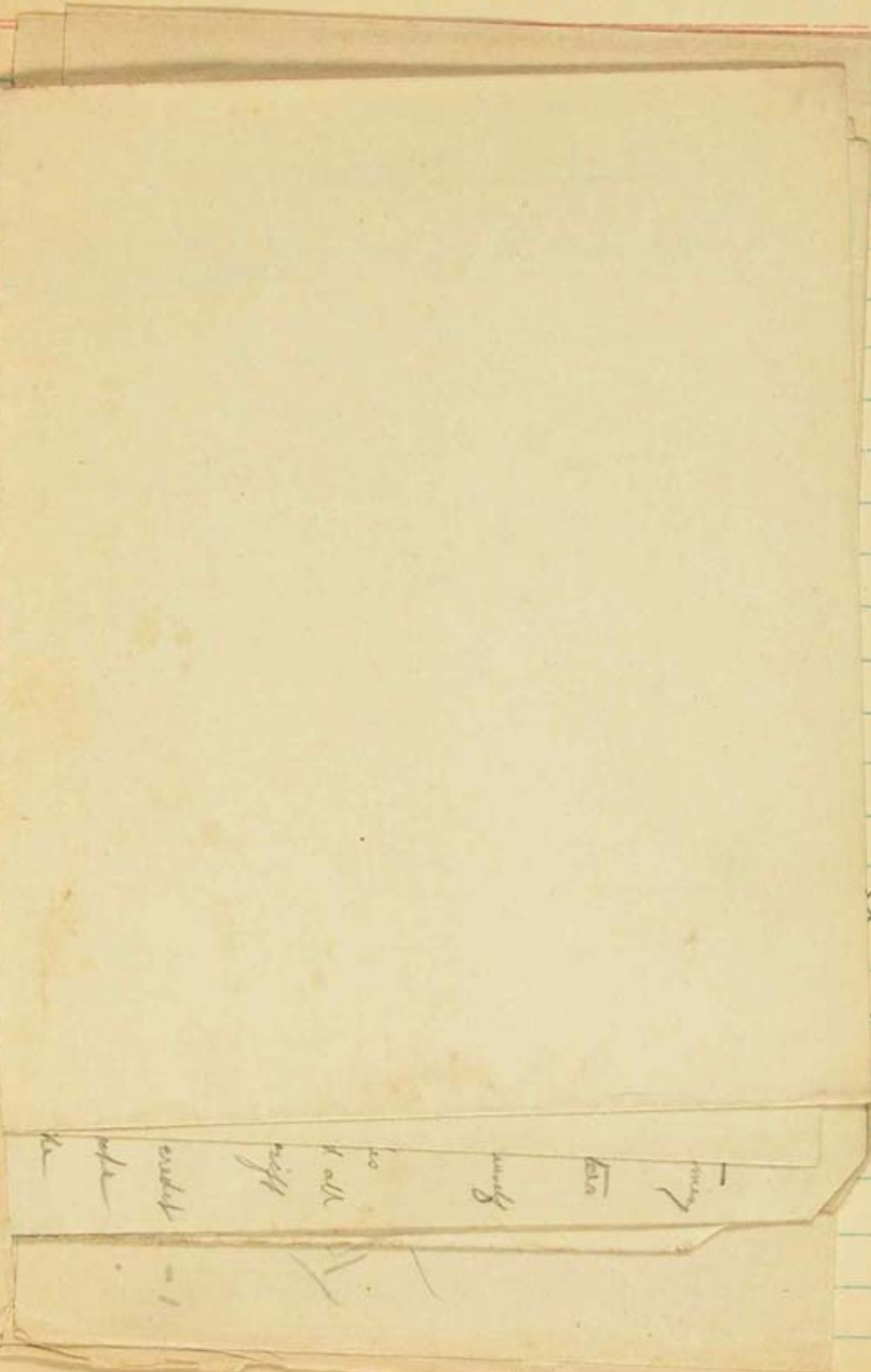
