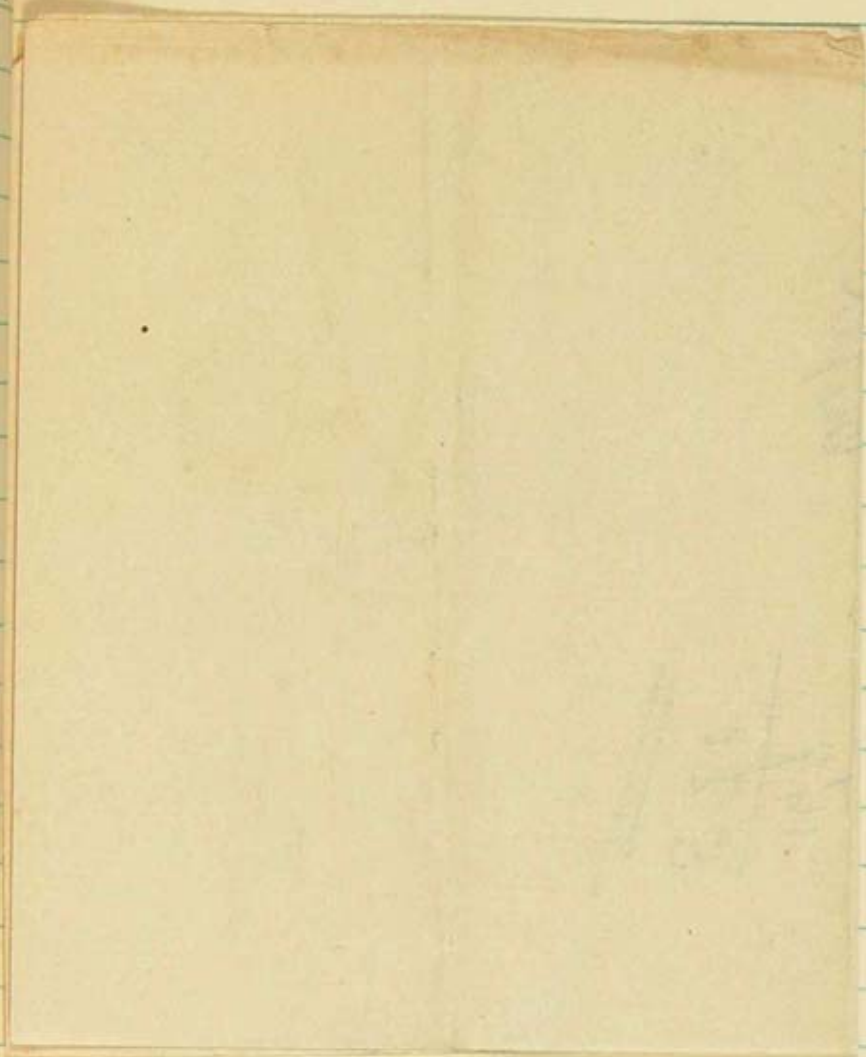

All went on for about an hour but suddenly, it was discovered, the radiator was flaming - the Cap had gone out, & the car had run without water for a while, but Ely. didn't mark it. When it was found, & water put in, it was also discovered that the water was dripping from under the radiator. It was my capture the radiator was leaking, but on paper examination it was found that the gasket had gone (burnt). We were at that time only about 5 miles from Maudla - Then commenced a one of the most amazing experiences in a Motor drive - on our way to Maudla & returning in the same car, all way (70 miles) - reading the Gita and studying the car. 
