What is Created is a true inner ^{actual inner} feeling - experience of the Truth - which is real, lasting and convincing. Then one knows by Actual Experience that one is in harmony with Every thing & Every one. - That there is nothing but One Infinite Indivisible Existence - all else fleeting shadows just as a human being knows by Actual experience that he is a Man - & Not an animal (dog - or horse etc) - he has Not to think about it that he is a Man, for he is that - So should one know by Actual Experience that he is One with every thing & every one - Not a separate individual entity, apart & away from others.

Bhakti (devotion) alone create Faith in Divinity & Divine Beings (Masters - Gurus etc) yet it is actual Experience that always matters. The visitors may hear a lot about B. from his enthusiastic devotees, but they shouldn't be carried away. Merely by these talks of others. They should themselves have that experience, feel like others - then alone it is real, lasting, convincing... Sauges (renunciation) is More internal than external. It is Not in giving us a shirking of one's duties towards one's own dependents, but in doing all these duties, conscientiously, in living & sharing their happiness & sufferings.
