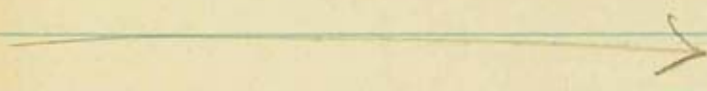

Ashram & the proposed Centre on the property gifted at Manilla - P. interested in all he heard - coming to the point, raised topic of B's writings & their translation - reminder of his promise for a Gujarat journal - Has the opportune moment been of the proposed Gujarat journal - Special privilege for translation of B's articles by P. - All names suggested, rejected..... Given the Nov. issue - kept it & said would reply later after reading.... When was he leaving Bombay? - 2:00 - Should I call in for a reply? - No - he would write.... address taken down by himself.....
- Strange as it may seem, G. looked rather distressed, inwardly tho' he wouldn't show it outwardly.... but the heart's agony could be hidden for a keen observer... During the course of formal talks, B. points out that it is not the intellectual gymnastics ^{and knowledge acquired} by reading or hearing lectures that spiritual truths could be understood. At the most these could give one an intellectual understanding, which is the first preparatory stage for entering into the Path... What is essential is a true inner feeling - ^{actual union} experience of the Truth - which is real, lasting and convincing. Then one knows by actual experience that one is in harmony with everything & every one - that there is nothing but One Infinite Indivisible Existence - all else floating shadows... Just as a human being knows by actual experience that he is a Man - & not an animal (dog - or horse etc) - he has not to think about it that he is a Man, for he is that - So should one know by actual experience that he is One with everything & everyone - not a separate individual entity, apart & away from others.
Bhakti (devotion) & love create faith in Divinity & Divine Beings (Masters - Gurus etc) yet it is actual experience that always matters. The visitors may hear a lot about B. from his enthusiastic devotees, but they shouldn't be carried away merely by these talks of others. They should themselves have that experience, & feel like others - then alone it is real, lasting, convincing... Sanyas (renunciation) is more internal than external. It is not in giving up & shirking of one's duties towards one's own dependants, but in doing all these duties, conscientiously, in living & sharing their happiness & sufferings
