Crossing over from Tallaimanar to Shanushkodi was rather smooth, but the real storm began on arrival at Shanushkodi. When the Indian Customs officer behaved most senselessly & without regard for any ^{affection} _{feeling} to be humane. Not only did they insist on examining every bag & baggage but eventually went to the limit & drew out the presence of each individual near his or her bag under examination. In strictly adhering to law and in their over-estimation of a sense of duty, they seemed to be too self-conscious of their position & forgot all code of humanity and gentlemanliness. Nowhere else have I traveled round the world did we ever experience this sort of treatment at the hands of customs and the most ridiculous part of it is that this most abominable treatment is meted out by our own people and in our own country - a most disgusting state of affairs to be admitted to the shame of our own country. As compared to this, the Cayton officer's treatment only last month, may be said to be most creditable.

The behavior & courtesy with which the railway official & their staff, especially the D.M. was so appreciable & needs special notice. They not only detained the train for us, but gave us all facilities for special accommodation for our party & spared us any cost for carrying our luggage with the guard.
