Sat B. at 3 p.m. ... General discussion represented Sheldon-world in general & Ind. in particular - Japan's strides & successes in the Pacific were surprising & with the fall of Singapore, prospects were v. gloomy, esp. for other countries in the vicinity like Burma & India. Topics then turning to the visit of Chiang Kai Shek to India, B. remarked that he was a great philosopher - a man of great spirit sincere & practical. It was a unique opportunity for party leaders in Ind. to meet together, or be brought together & a solution to the deadlock found thru his influence & influence. But it was surprising & pity that Ind. lost this opportunity - naturally offered. What earthly use did anyone gain by presenting each other in cuboidal terms - praising each other's greatness & flattery - the speaking of the greatest admiringly of G. as a great leader - also of the greatness of Nehru & Jawaharlal etc & they all in turn calling him as the greatest leader - etc etc. The Govt. & the leaders both had lost this wonderful opportunity of settling the differences which his influence - as a third party respected by all - would have brought out. --
