15 WEDNESDAY

1943

Rainy early before 5 a.m. - rolling up our bedding, we left the Punjab Hotel for Pk. - approx. 6-15... had secured us 3<sup>rd</sup> cl. Comp.!!  
Sea & platform... lunch at hala. Musayun train - During the journey, B's eyes were always about to find a suitable 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> - pointed out some -  
- in train, a young Sikh, B's going to... with his family, accommodated himself  
off to B... of Superior were made, but not first fit... B. liked him for  
his certain innate qualities, humility etc... had some prayers given  
with his own hands... And... 4<sup>th</sup> B... the Sea was lower...  
Another - after that was, also found a really in our compartment  
was for a seat opp. to B... had meals with us... (the headmaster) & we  
left him at Gujaratwala Tour, when we took our journey, for a few hours  
rook here..

Immediately on arrival, however, we had an unpleasant  
struggle with the S.M. re: our important letters, being re-directed by him  
to the P.O. (instead of keeping them, as usual, at Pk. in the box)...  
On being asked why he did so - instead of simply des. our mistake, he  
showed an adamant attitude, a refusal to argue with us, say, we have  
at liberty to report... & other we told him - It was all unexpected &  
undesirable of a railway official (responsible) -

At P.O. we were re-directed to the T.O. Thus due to Pk. & Pk. &  
port, we reported it to the T.O. staff: who regretted the attitude of the  
S.M. & were kind enough to show us the copy of file - even for us one  
(freshly made copy) - What difference had the two public servants?

P. discussion - B. today, in a most confidential talk with me alone, declared  
his wish to go personally distribute grain & clothing to the poor & the needy... he  
would stay here for a month, in a private house, preferably a student's room, if any,  
and with the help of the work, do other important work. The room would go  
around from house to house, to bring the really poor & needy to B...  
who would personally feed & clothe them... This personal touch, under  
such conditions, had a special significance & importance for his work -  
and he therefore wished to have through inquiries suggested & arrangements  
made for some exp. rep. grant - if it could be available, to such large  
quantities as to us as individual parties - at cheap rates. B. was  
prepared to have spent ex. ten thousand for this ....!

later ..... at 5 p.m. go again - walking - find him all alone but 2124 -  
3 told us to wait below the steps outside - we had understood to stay inside -  
to make her more sure B. asked Bdl. to approach & return but before Bdl.

did so. Sara pushed on him a face her good to do so ..... This  
was not desired, as B. himself wanted being 20 p.m. & 20 p.m. by him.  
It was a bit disappointing, as it seemed for his talks, but in order not  
to discourage Bdl. to blame us for no fault but misunderstood.  
he took the incident calmly, bearing the "brunt" himself. She wrote  
for us making her as B. described all above, & what her behavior mood was  
quite OK - but his 20 p.m. to Bdl. first, spoiled the game, & the work.  
and B. was half done on some subject - he would come again,  
& finish the job - now that ... Bdl.'s particular tract was under  
repeating whatever he said. ....

B. was all the time 1. active, in spite of his recent past. -

Kul-Mokal - Returning home, I suggested taking a chance if the 5-35  
train to K. Mokal was late - Bdl. was sent to inquire. I had heard  
was on the flat form, everything was packed off in a rush - within  
a few hrs. we packed ourselves carefully accommodated in a  
few small compartments by a Railway Servant. .... B. & we all were  
hungry, but no food was to be found on str. & there was no time to  
go out to buy it. .... We left Kul. at 7 p.m. & a half late. Arrived  
K. Mokal at 8:30 - in the dark. The str. was out of the side way  
str. on bridge lines, with an S.M. - ant. & 2 others, who were busy with  
themselves the whole time. They all knew B. party, who had been here  
in  
- Now for work. A good job, nothing could be had, missed catch, but  
expected coming to be put in the village. A paper was first to find  
us - in the dark - we walked in the dark night, through by ways -  
(no fence road except foot path - then bushes) over a hill - reached  
the masi place - away cement were made as desired for B. & the  
above with him for a few moments - we 2 remained at the  
compartment - as a detour. B. returned - after 15 hrs. happy with  
the work done! That was the first fact! Had a meal. .... A Sd. Sd.  
Zamindar - Amersing - was informed of our party's arrival - He invited

at the str. - that he had himself bought meals in 2 hrs. - mainly was ready  
- we walked back to str. with huge messes, with the walk in cool  
- night a walk done - 3 chairs were kept ready by the str. staff.

## Lahore - Mast. trip around

This Morning, B. started c.g. - in a tonga with Hal - Ch. on a short mast. trip around rehering @ 3 pm. Survey here 6 hours, he contacted 5 masts - 2 of these being v. important & special types - the Kafangwatta Base (Gilyay gates) near Kuruwa as and the old lady - near

The other 3 were of lesser importance - one Nawaloka in Bhogwanpura, one Kuttawalla Bana - w  
a descendant of the old one named w

B. was v. happy. Cf. at heavy contacted the 2 former, besides the 3 others. The first one was found, however arrived & brought to us for the surrounding locality, but being found not on a road at the level B. decided to see others after came - @ 12:30 to meet him again. A cross contacted at @ 2 pm. - He was then surrounded by many, but they were asked to leave him alone, and then to finish his work with him, all alone, in a few moments. Two big new kites were purchased, with a bundle of threads - both white & extra - and were personally handed over to the Mast by B. -

The other - old lady - was also of a high order - with a Sweet Gyan on her face - mild & weak - zigzag about a way in open fields near a well marshes, all day & night - and the dibbar near the Chauke - at times surrounded by keeps - who wouldn't disturb her. Food brought by many respectable ladies, who came with a term bag, was only chewed & thrown out - and new best clothes were torn to pieces - money, 5 rupees were also thrown away -
