 a term bag, was only chew & kind at 4:00 pm - and new
 best clothes were torn to pieces & money, 5 rupees were also
 given away -

Relief-Work - for the poor & the destitute - in Bengal
due to Famine

The Subject came under discussion with the Mandali this Morning, when B. declared his desire to undertake this Work in Calcutta, with the help of a few H.S.O.s. Idea excellent & wise, whole-hearted, unflinching but V. differed just for hitches on its practical side & also for doing same work - elsewhere (in Bengal) rather than in Calcutta itself.

B. explained that - his work was NOT purely for external (physical) relief and aid, but had a spiritual significance - as always - Relief work, for feeding masses, just on any street - where there is distress - in times of need, & people die in streets - by scores, it creates a sp. situation. And his work, for those in dire & real need, with food - clothing personally given, would have a double significance - beneficial to all concerned. All this World-Crisis & Suffering - amidst it - is to create & does create in mankind, a hatred, anger - for thos. who, however attractive & dear - parents giving away their own children - husbands deserting wives - etc. are all indications of a feeling of detachment from maya - when actually a hatred against thos. mundane things springs up - ^{for me} To work under these conditions, is v. important and beneficial - not only to individuals coming thus in direct contact, but thru them, to others (masses) of the same class, & humanity in general. Otherwise - what is one spending Rs 1000 per hour - for feeding the poor? Altho. we can ill-afford immediately, materially, if efforts & better - when thousands are in distress - & lives are spent. But given under conditions of desperation - as explained above - by me personally, to the truly poor & the needy, selected & brought by H.S.O.s - it has a great significance & far-reaching effect.

B. emphatically & repeatedly declared that he does NOT wish to be known to anyone there - & this identity MUST be kept secret & undisclosed

The dog bite - This evening, the black dog, fed & nourished by the ladies, & by my always in their bungalow - suddenly, rushed on Mary, & bit her both. the question whether it was the action of a mad dog, or ordinary was under discussion & a remedy for same to be taken tomorrow - presently taking precautionary measures.

Gathering all Maudali near him, B. explained the probable situation in Bengal and how he managed to do his work in cognate with the Aid of the Maudali.....

Immediately after his return, the New Query, Havell visited Calcutta, whose condition - B. said - would now change either way - for the best or for the worst. Similar Crisis are to follow throughout India - esp. in big Cities like Bombay..... He has been repeatedly saying for years that India must suffer - most of all - This is the beginning. Even the best conditions of famine, people dying in streets on open pavements - Never before seen or heard of..... This is but one phase of what is ^{still} to follow..... After all that suffering, the Country's condition will improve. Altho' apparently the fault is thrown on Dr. Post, as the principal responsible Auth. only, who could poor Army or Ch. do - against the Divine will? Had it not been for my B. their fate would have been worst.....

Discussing future Mex. conditions possibly here & the severe cold in Delhi. Famine would be unbearable for many of the poor - esp. the old folks, due to ^{asthma} conditions of regulations (restricting movement) & strikes that help keeping warm (likely rising) with water pipe outside the bungalow would be impossible..... Hence B. decided to move again to Mirabad next month
