At Dhond this evening, the work for which B. had sent me was done in a few moments; the train literally stood in front of the person concerned: had a talk with him in 2 ms. finished the job in 2 ms. & took the return train to Mannu, just waiting on the other side — Otherwise, I wd have to take the train (matters trail) ka Kalyan to go to Mannu & back.... to arrive next evening latest.
