the Akram boys started for the "Shonwad -
Paratka-mala" trip - @ 2 miles from Raigarh
arriving there at @ 8:30.

Tea was served to all these, immediately
on arrival (Already kept ready by Bapu &
& other Mandal members going there before)
Some fruit also were distributed to each,
with the sweet gathias (Gathias) (the sweet

Inakia, which was very nice indeed -
Rice - dal - Bhaji - aachar etc.

After the meals were over, the boys & the maudah returned to In'abad - quite alright, after enjoying a nice boat - of a boat ride as well as a feast - all the arrangements for which proved indeed very splendid - without any hitch. The "Radio" programme was postponed, as Farok had gone away with the keys of the shop.

In short, the day had proved to be very enjoyable - with 2 boats outside In'abad, which for the Ashrautes particularly, was indeed more than a treat. But the wonder of it all was
