The Shanghai armistice was signed by China and Japan on Thursday and "witnessed" by the British, American, Italian, and French Ministers. It is not a perfect instrument either as an armistice or as a means of Sino-Japanese conciliation. But it is a good step forward on the difficult way. It separates the two forces and lessens the probability of renewed fighting.
