REGULATIONS.

Passports are available, in the first instance, for five years from the date of issue, unless otherwise stated. They may be renewed for a further maximum period of five years. Thereafter, or if at any time the passport contains no further space for visas, a new passport must be obtained. The fee for an Indian passport is Rs. 10/-, and the fee for renewal is Rs. 2/- for each year, or portion of a year, for which the passport is renewed.

(a) A passport including particulars of the holder's wife is not available for the wife's use when travelling alone.

(b) Children who are above 15 years of age require separate passports.

3. The passport is only available for travel to the countries named on page 4, but may be endorsed for additional countries. The fee for each further endorsement is Re. 1/-. The possession of a passport so endorsed does not, however, exempt the holder from compliance with any immigration laws in force in a country, or from the necessity of obtaining a visa where required.

4. Passports endorsed as valid for the Commonwealth countries are also available for travelling to territory under British protection, not, however, the Aden Protectorate for which both an endorsement and a visa are required.

5. Passports cannot be issued or renewed on behalf of persons not residing at the time being in the country in which the application is made. Passports should not be sent out of the country by post.

REGISTRATION.

It is most important that Indian subjects resident abroad should at the earliest opportunity register their names and addresses at the nearest Indian Embassy, Legation or Consulate, or Office of an Indian Representative. Changes of addresses or departure from the country should also be notified to them.

Failure to register may in a period of emergency result in difficulty or delay in according to Indian Subjects the assistance and protection to which they are entitled.

CAUTION.

THIS PASSPORT IS A VALUABLE DOCUMENT. IT SHOULD NOT BE ALLOWED TO PASS INTO THE POSSESSION OF ANY UNAUTHORISED PERSON. IF LOST OR DESTROYED, THE FACT AND CIRCUMSTANCES SHOULD BE IMMEDIATELY REPORTED TO THE NEAREST "PASSPORT ISSUING AUTHORITY" IN INDIA, OR (IF THE HOLDER IS ABROAD) TO THE NEAREST INDIAN DIPLOMATIC OR CONSULAR OFFICER OR OTHER REPRESENTATIVE, AND TO THE LOCAL POLICE.

THIS PASSPORT MUST NOT BE ALTERED OR MUTILATED IN ANY WAY, NOR ANY ENDORSEMENT MADE ON IT BY ANY PERSON OTHER THAN A DULY AUTHORISED OFFICIAL.
