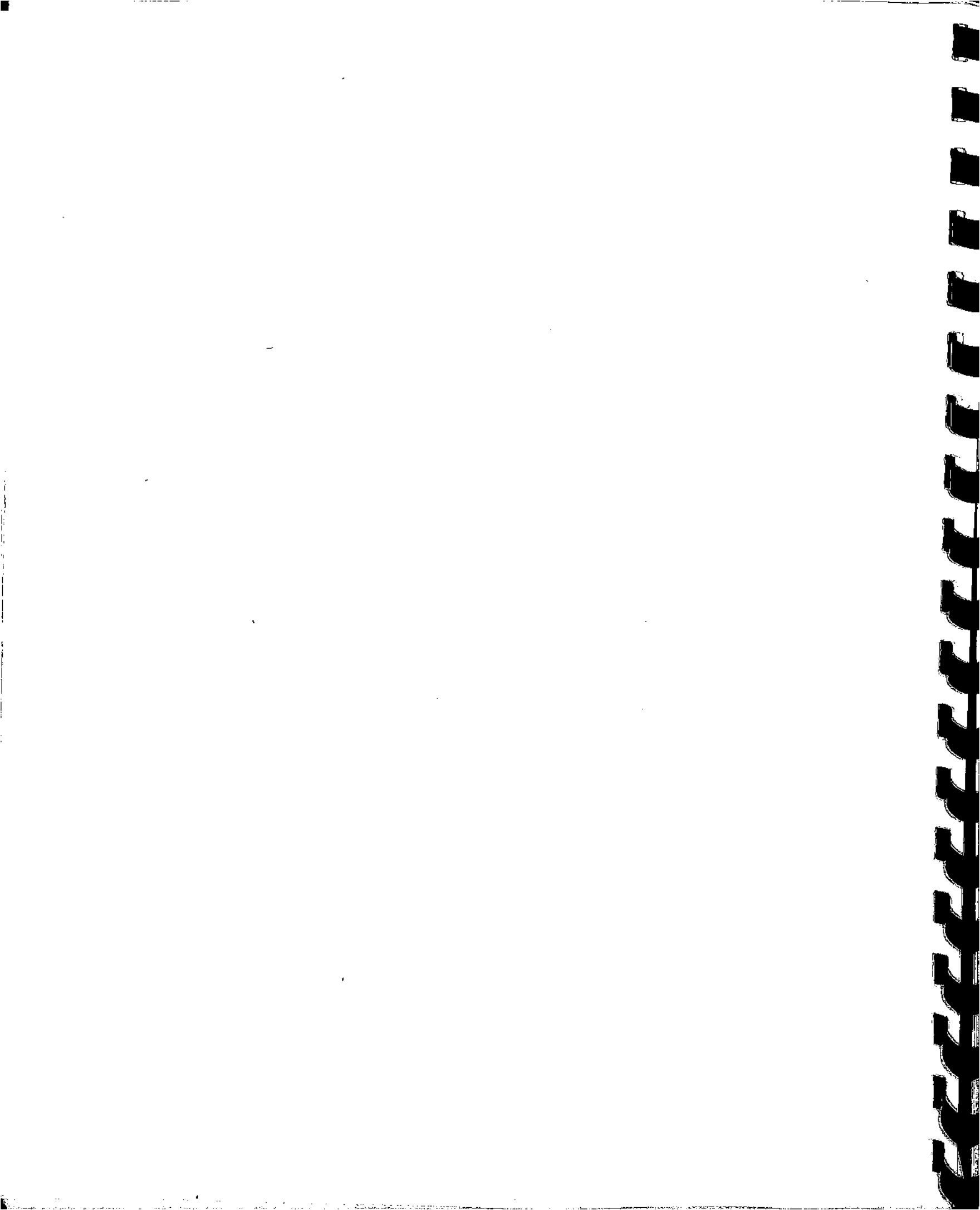
Dear Meher Baba,

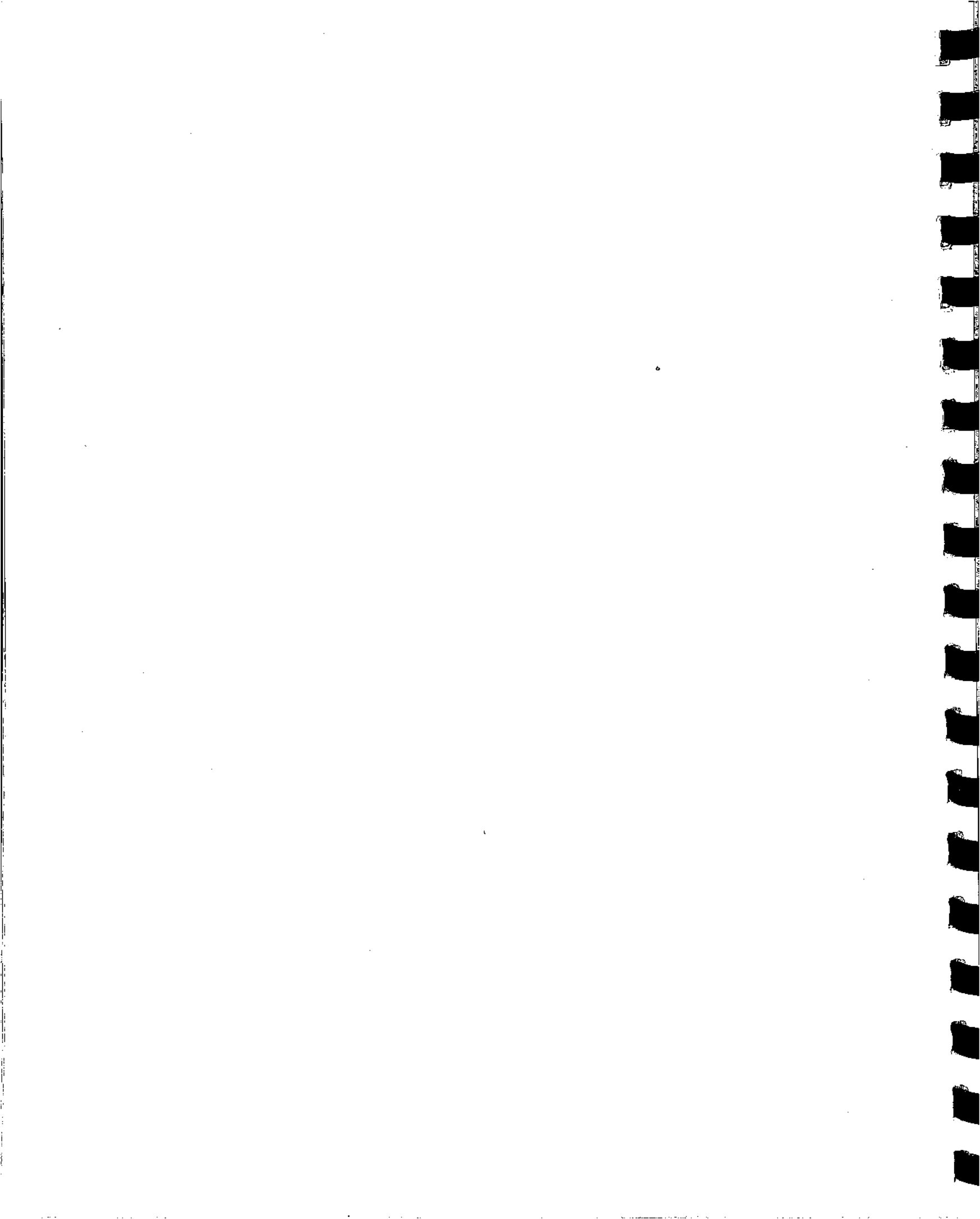
Last night I dreamt of Meher Baba, or rather he ushered me into a very real dream which I take to be about my future. Went to bed in the early morning after doing some translation work on Castenada's "Teachings of Don Juan" and feeding and lulling my baby son, who had waked up. I was feeling quite strange, not sleepy but not sleepless either, sort of nowhere; then, rather suddenly, I kind of zoomed-in to the dream mentioned above, passing along the way, first, a clear image of Baba's closeup that is on the liner of Peter Townshend's album; then, almost immediately, there was Baba himself in front of me, still smiling but now gazing down pensively, immobile but living and real. I was awed and overjoyed, and at the same time thought that now I would be able to learn something about Baba first hand. This mood of intellectual inquisitiveness I hold responsible for the subsequent befuddling of the dream. Then next thing I remember clearly is looking down from the top of a hill towards a blue sea, not too far away. The shore, and the hillside, were wooded with small, very green trees--discounting the sea, it was not unlike a Castaneda landscape or the hill seen in the second liner photo of "Who Came First." To my left, on the top of the hill, was a little round table with a white or light yellow tablecloth, and upon it lay a book, its pages lightly



stirred by a breeze. It was open, I think, on the first page, and there I managed to read something to the effect that Meher Baba was "the silent guru" because he didn't need to speak--he just fixed his thoughts on God and every one of his disciples felt His presence wherever they might be. (This last clause was somehow stressed to me after I thought it was a misreading on my part and that the sentence surely referred to those disciples who were with him at the moment.)

There came another transition period, and then a very concrete dream about myself and my family. What I call the Baba vision had had an extraordinary visual reality; the personal dream was quite real even to the touch, though I knew myself asleep and, in the dream, said so to my wife--but kind of joking, for I was none too sure. She seemed to think I only felt so because I had just dropped acid; I remembered having done so and for the rest of the dream couldn't make up my mind as to whether I was dreaming or having a trip.

Talking about the Townshend album some days ago, a friend of mine referred to Baba as "the guru who didn't speak." I know nothing about Baba and meant to ask my friend about his not speaking, but the topic changed and I forgot. I don't think my friend knows very much about Baba, either,



so I am writing to you. Please send me all the information you can, Rick, and I hope my "vision" will be of some interest to you.

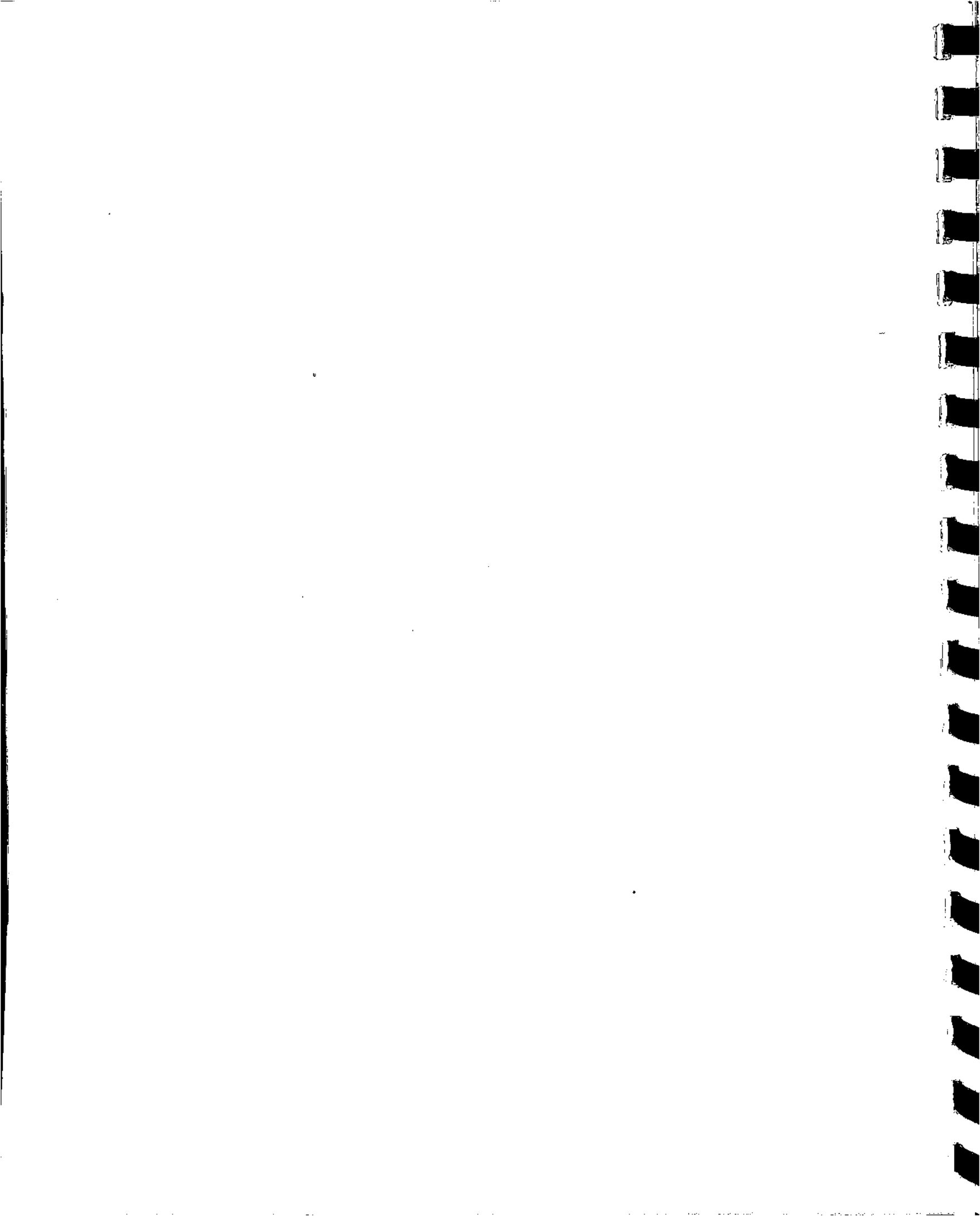

TECHNIQUES that use JAPA or MALA BEADS or not.

I am RESEARCHING all those traditions EAST & WEST & in-between that use the various methods & techniques for making CONTACT with the SOUND CURRENT (NAM, HOLY SPIRIT, OM, THE WORD, SCIENCE OF BREATH, etc.) and the various means of achieving the goal of SELF-REALIZATION & GOD-REALIZATION through MEDIATIONS (BUDDHIST, MOSLEM, HINDU, CHRISTIAN, SUFI, etc.) and other TRANSPERSONAL PSYCHOLOGY approaches.

If i'm not able to acquire the "genuine article" could you send me a good "color photo" of the "article" (JAPA or MALA BEADS) taht one uses during MEDIATION or YOGA POSTURES.

(2) The other purpose relates to the above----does your organization or GURU put out a MAGAZINE, JOURNAL, NEWSLETTER dealing with the teachings of your sect? 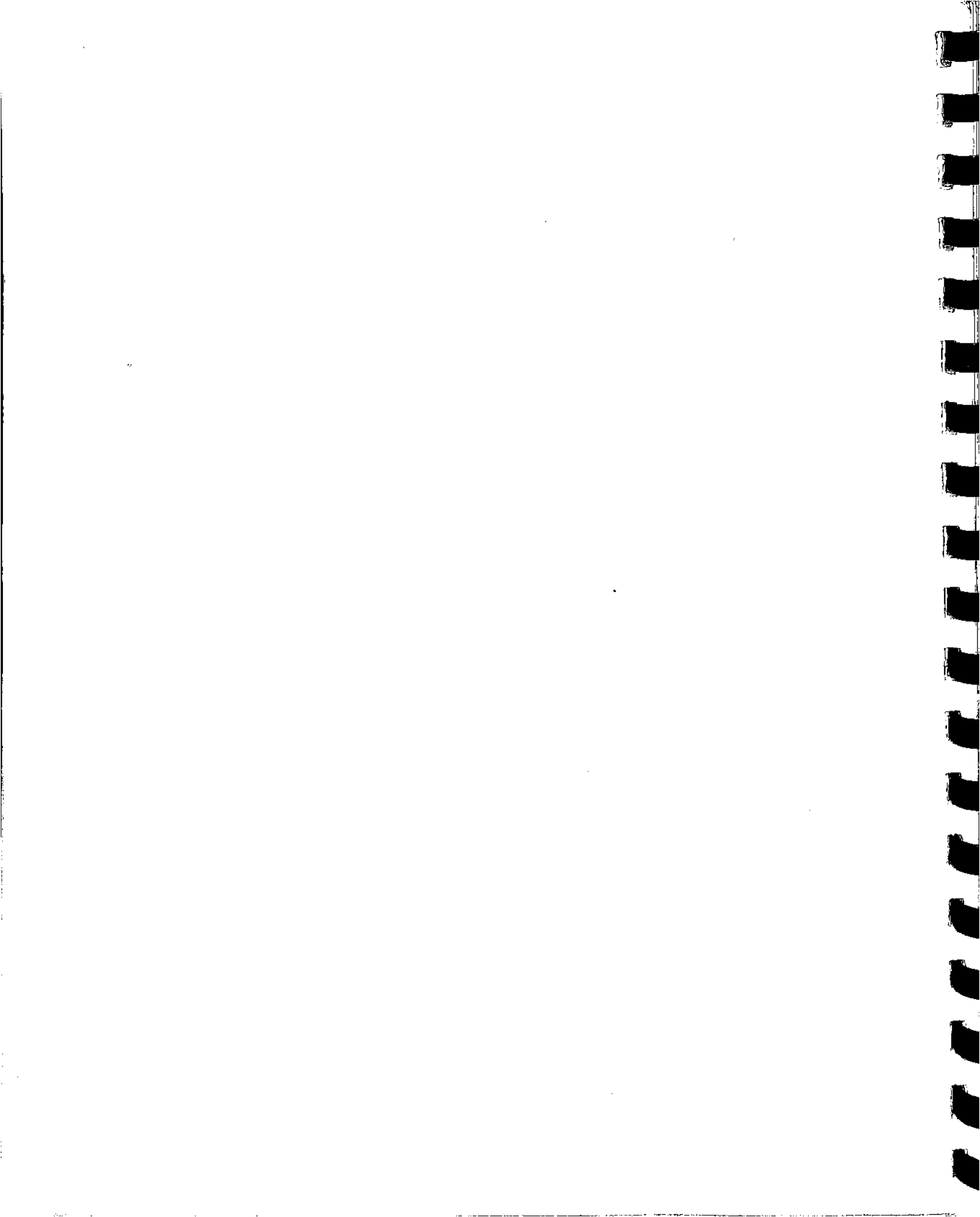
